

**KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON
RESOLUTION NO. 647**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, entering into and adopting an Interlocal Agreement with the Cedar River Water and Sewer District.

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34 provides that local government units may cooperate to make the most efficient use of their powers on the basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, there is an area of land as shown attached to the Interlocal Agreement, Exhibit "A", which is not designated for service by either party on the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan Service Area Map; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners that it would be in the best interest of King County Water District No. 90 to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Cedar River Water and Sewer District designating King County Water District No. 90 as the logical service provider for the area delineated on the map attached to the Interlocal Agreement and recommending the change to the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan Service Area Map;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, hereby approve and adopt the Interlocal Agreement by and between the District and Cedar River Water and Sewer District attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between **KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90**, a Washington Municipal Corporation, and **CEDAR RIVER WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT**, a Washington Municipal Corporation, this ____ day of _____, 1996, as follows:

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34 provides that local government units may cooperate to make the most efficient use of their powers on the basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, there is an area of land as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" which is not designated for service by either party on the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan Service Area Map; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to designate King County Water District No. 90 as the logical service provider for the area of land shown on Exhibit "A" and to recommend the change to the East King County Coordinated Water System Plan Service Area Map;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. King County Water District No. 90 is the logical service provider for water services to the geographical area shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

2. The East King County Coordinated Water System Plan Service Area Map, and the Comprehensive Water System Plan of each municipality, shall be amended to reflect

that King County Water District No. 90 is the logical service provider for the geographical area shown on Exhibit "A".

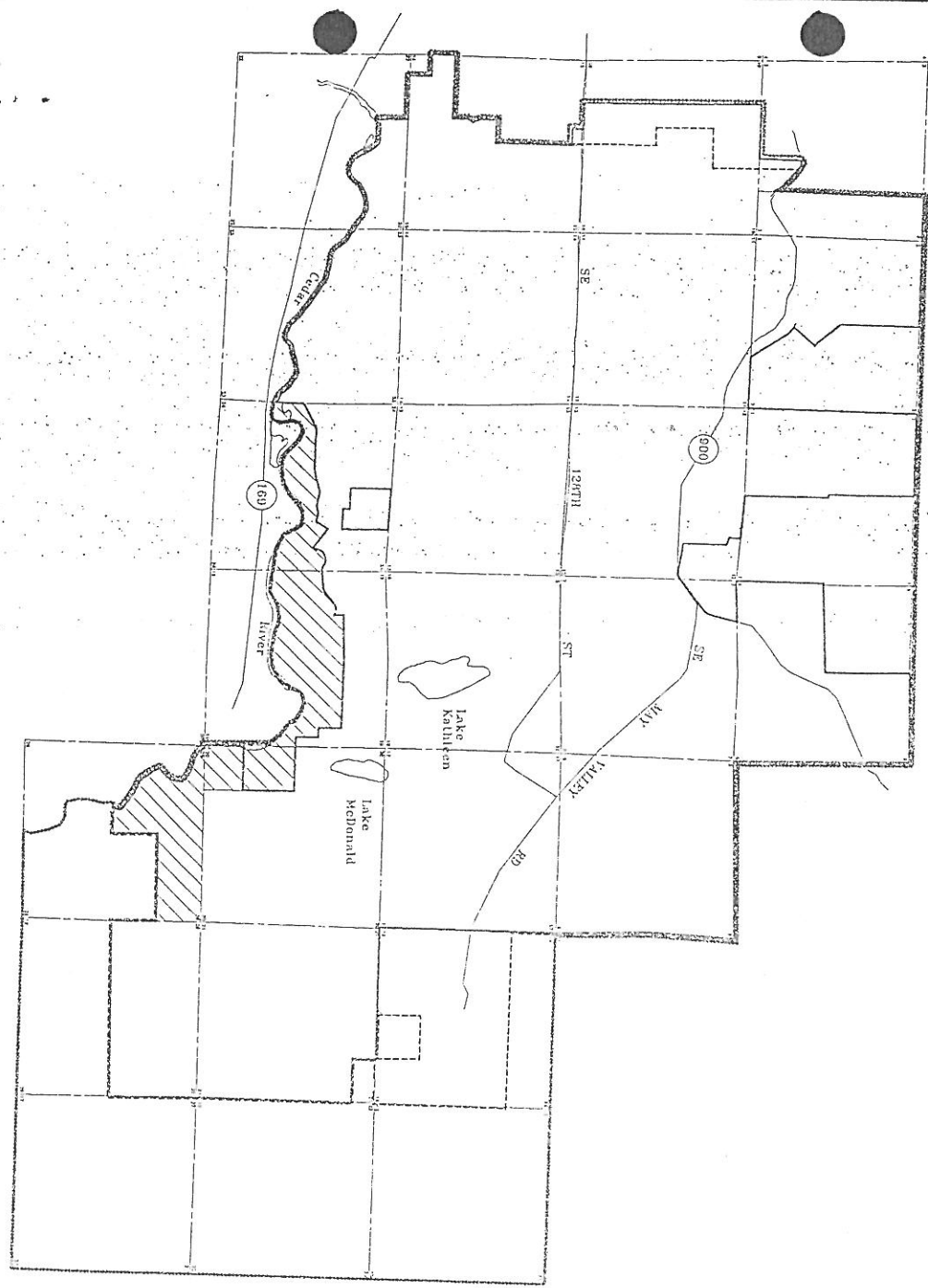
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
