## **RESOLUTION NO. 990**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, making a finding, pursuant to SEPA, that implementation of The Comprehensive Water System Plan, 2015, does not present a probable significant adverse impact on the environment.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, have heretofore declared their intention to implement The Comprehensive Water System Plan, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 have determined it advisable to conduct an environmental assessment; and

WHEREAS, notice of the Determination of Nonsignificance prepared in accordance with SEPA Rules has been published in a newspaper of general circulation within the location of the proposed property; and

WHEREAS, the Determination of Nonsignificance and Environmental Checklist have been circulated in accordance with SEPA regulations and the time for comments has elapsed; and no comments have been received in response thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has adopted the environmental checklist, having considered each item thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90 AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Commissioners do formally adopt and make part of this Resolution an environmental assessment consisting of the environmental checklist, a copy of same being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the Commissioners do hereby make a declaration of nonsignificance based upon the findings of Exhibit "A".

Section 3: That the District Manager is directed to record this Resolution in the SEPA register maintained by the District.
