A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, entering into and adopting the Cross-Connection Control Program.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, is empowered and authorized by RCW 57 to establish and implement a Cross-Connection Control Program ((CCP); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of establishing a Cross-Connection Control Program is to protect the public water system as defined in WAC 246-290-010, from contamination via cross-connections; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 has been advised that the Cross-Connection Control Program must be adopted by Resolution to remain in compliance in accordance with WAC 246-290-490; and

WHEREAS, a Cross-Connection Control Program has previously been implemented by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90; and

WHEREAS, the District's Cross-Connection Control Program (CCP) attached hereto properly describes the operating policies and technical provisions of the District's CCP and the correct actions used to ensure that customers comply with the District's cross-connection control requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 does hereby adopt the attached Cross-Connection Control Program.

<u>Section 2:</u> That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
