RESOLUTION NO. 1005 A KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90 KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, approving a petition for annexation commonly referred to as Winterbrook Farms Annexation and providing notice of public hearing.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 57.24.070 as amended by the laws of 1985 Chapter 141, Section 8, the Commissioners are empowered to entertain a petition in writing for annexation containing an area contiguous to its District boundaries as signed by the owners according to the records of the County Auditor of not less than 60% of the area of land for which annexation is petitioned, excluding county and state rights of way, parks, tidelands, lakes, retention ponds, and stream and water courses; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have received a petition complying with said state laws and containing the necessary legal data; and

WHEREAS, said petition has been certified by the District's consulting engineer; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners are required pursuant to RCW 57.24.080 to provide for a public hearing and cause notice of said hearing to be published in one issue of general circulation within the area to be annexed and area required to post such notice in three public places within the area of the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, said notice shall specify the time and place of hearing and invite interested persons to appear and voice approval or disapproval of the annexation commonly referred to as Winterbrook Farms Annexation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90 AS FOLLOWS:

 $\underline{\textbf{Section 1:}}$ The Commissioners do find the petition herein in compliance with the laws of the State of Washington.

Section 2: The Commissioners do direct the staff to publish and post proper notice of the public hearing for said annexation to be held on the 21st day of June, 2016, at 4:30 p.m. at the District office of King County Water District No. 90, 15606 SE 128th Street, Renton, Washington, and that said notice shall invite interested persons to appear and voice approval or disapproval of the proposed annexation referred to as Serenity Estates/Issaquah Highlands.

Section 3: The District staff is to charge and collect the expenses of publication and posting of the notice to and from the signers of the petition for annexation.
