

**KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON
RESOLUTION NO. 1050**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, providing for an increase and changes in the current general facility connection charges charged by the District and adopting the new charges.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is required to impose rates, charges and fees which are adequate to provide for the District's costs of operation, maintenance and repair of its systems, for the construction of necessary capital improvements, and for services that it renders on behalf of persons doing business with or receiving service from the District; and

WHEREAS, the District's staff will from time to time present data to the Board of Commissioners for its review to determine the rates and charges necessary to maintain and operate the District, and to provide an appropriate level of services consistent with the prudent financial management of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to increase the District's general facility charge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, that effective February 19, 2019, the General Facility Charge of King County Water District No. 90 shall be as follows:

SECTION 1: The general facility charge of the District will be as set forth below, except property within the area designated by the District as High Valley will be charged the GFC-HV High Valley GFC, as follows:

-General Facility Charge* \$7,100.00 for 5/8" and 1" Meter

-GFC-HV High Valley GFC* \$8,400.00 for 5/8" and 1" Meter

*Meters above 1": The GFC charge will be calculated by applicable ERU or SPU Chart





SECTION 2: District staff will update the District's Schedule of Charges to reflect the increases to the respective general facility charges.


