RESOLUTION NO. 1071

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, increasing the District charge for water meter full installations.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 90 ("District") has established charges to install water meters and to provide water service to District customers; and

WHEREAS, the District now desires to update and increase the charge for full water meter installations, hydrant installations and related charges, to fully recover the costs incurred by the District for such installations and connection to the District's system, including the cost of permits from other governmental agencies owning or controlling the right-of-way in which meter installations may occur;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Schedule of Charges section "New Service Costs" adopted pursuant to Resolution 1067 on January 7, 2020, is amended as follows:

SECTION 2: Meter Installation. The meter installation charge set forth in Section 1 is

subject to increase if District staff determine in their sole discretion that the cost of installing the

service will require additional time, material, and/or administrative costs due to unique factors

related to the installation. For example, and not by way of limitation, the installation charge may

increase due to location relative to the water main, traffic control requirements, additional permitting

requirements, topography, condition of soils, vegetation, conflict with other utilities, paving

requirements, and other factors. In such case, District staff shall have the authority to require a

Deposit in excess of the meter installation charge which they deem to be a more accurate estimate

of the cost of installation. If the installation cost is less than the Deposit, the District shall refund the

difference between such cost and the Deposit, but not in an amount less than meter installation

charge set forth in Section 1. If the installation cost is greater than the Deposit, the applicant shall

be required to pay the difference between the installation cost and the Deposit to the District as a

condition of receiving water service from the District

If during construction the District encounters factors that result in additional installation costs

for which no deposit was collected, such costs shall also be charged and paid as a condition of

receiving water service from the District.

The additional cost of an installation shall be charged on a time and materials basis based

on the District's current rate schedules, plus any permit fees or other District incurred charges, plus

twenty (20) percent of the total of all such fees and charges for the District's administrative and

overhead costs attributable thereto.

SECTION 3: Hydrant Installation. All hydrant installations shall be charged on a time and

materials basis based on the District's current rate schedules, plus any permit fees or other District

incurred charges, plus twenty (20) percent of the total of all such fees and charges for the District's

administrative and overhead costs attributable thereto (collectively the "Hydrant Installation Cost"),

plus the cost of the hydrant.

The applicant shall pay a deposit to the District in the amount set forth in Section 1 ("Deposit)

based on the location of the hydrant to apply to the Hydrant Installation Cost, provided if the Hydrant

Installation Cost is less than the Deposit, the District shall refund the difference between the Hydrant

Installation Cost and the Deposit; or if the Hydrant Installation Cost is greater than the Deposit, the

applicant shall be required to pay the difference between the Hydrant Installation Cost and the

Deposit to the District as a condition of receiving water service from the District; provided, further, if

District staff determine in their sole discretion that the cost of installing the hydrant installation will

exceed the applicable Deposit set forth in Section 1, District staff shall have the authority to require a

greater Deposit which they deem to be a more accurate estimate of the Hydrant Installation Cost.

SECTION 4: Condition to installation and service. Any party or applicant for water

service requiring a full meter installation, meter drop, hydrant installation, owing other General Fees,

or owing any other sums of monies to the District, shall pay to the District the amount(s) owing as a

precondition to the initiation of any installation and the providing of water service by the District.

EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY, AND REPEALER

a. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of

Commissioners.

b. Severability. If any Section, sentence, clause or part of the Resolution is for any

reason determined invalid, such determination shall not affect the remaining portions of the

Resolution. The Board of Commissioners hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution

and each Section, sentence, clause and part thereof despite the fact that one or more Sections,

sentences, clauses and parts thereof be declared invalid.
