RESOLUTION NO. 1076

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, authorizing adoption of the 2020-2025 King County

Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, with District Annex.

WHEREAS, all of King County has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life,

property, environment, and the County's economy; and

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or

eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS. State and Federal laws establish requirements for pre- and post-disaster

hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS, a coalition of King County, Cities, Towns, and Special Purpose Districts with

like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation

strategies within the King County planning area; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public,

assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy

consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing,

evaluating and revising this strategy, with the last plan completed in 2015; and

WEHEREAS, the District has completed an Annex to the plan to address the particular

needs of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County

Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the District adopts in its entirety the 2020-2025 King County Regional

Hazard Mitigation Plan (RHMP), plus the District's Annex to the RHMP.

SECTION 2: That the District will use the adopted and approved portions of the RHMP to guide pre- and post-disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.

SECTION 3: That the District will coordinate the strategies identified in the RHMP with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.

SECTION 4: That the District will continue its support of the Steering Committee and continue to participate in the planning partnership set forth in the RHMP.

SECTION 5: That the District will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all RHMP planning partners.
