RESOLUTION NO. 1080

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District, No. 90, King County, Washington, declaring as surplus the 2000 International Vactor Truck, Model #2110-86, Serial #00-06-7310, Cat C12 Serial #2KS30682 ("Vactor Truck"), and authorizing public sale through the State of Washington Enterprise Services, Surplus Operations.

WHEREAS, the Vactor Truck no longer meets the District's present or future operational requirements, and is being replaced; and

WHEREAS, the Vactor Truck has an estimated remaining value in excess of \$2,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Vactor Truck is hereby declared to be surplus.

SECTION 2: That in accordance with RCW 57.08.015, the District shall give notice of intention to sell the surplus property once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the District. The notice shall describe the surplus property and state that it will be offered for sale through the State of Washington Enterprise Services, Surplus Operations, for public sale on the terms and conditions set forth by the agency. The District reserves the right to reject any and all bids for good cause.

SECTION 3: That following the publication of notice, the surplus property shall be disposed of by public sale to the highest bidder through the State of Washington Enterprises Services, Surplus Operations, with a minimum bid of \$6,000.00. District staff is authorized to accept less than the minimum bid if efforts to obtain the minimum bid are unsuccessful.
