

**KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90
KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON
RESOLUTION NO. 968**

A **RESOLUTION** of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, entering into and adopting the 2013-2018 Regional Water Use Efficiency Goal.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, is empowered by RCW 57.08.100 to enter into contracts for water use efficiency; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 that it would be in the best interest of King County Water District No. 90 to participate in the 2013-2018 Regional Water Use Efficiency Goal; and;

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 90 has provided notice of a public meeting at least two weeks prior to the open public meeting, outlining the purpose of the meeting, the date of the meeting, the time of the meeting, location of the meeting, and information supporting the District's goal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 have been advised that the Regional Water Use Efficiency Goal must be adopted in order for the District to implement the goal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 90, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90 does hereby adopts the following six year Regional Water Use Efficiency Goal: Reduce per capita water use from current levels so that the total average annual retail water use of the members of the Saving Water Partnership is less than 105 MGD from 2013 through 2018 despite forecasted population growth.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
