RESOLUTION NO. 1115

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington addressing the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in King County and throughout the United States.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the District adopted Resolution No. 1074 setting forth policies to address the Covid-19 Emergency; and

WHEREAS, emergency orders have been revised or terminated such that a revisions to Resolution No. 1074 are appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. Section 1 of Resolution 1074 is cancelled. The General Manager has, and continues to be authorized, to develop policies and procedures for the billing, payment, and collection of District revenue, including offering payment plans to customers as previously authorized.
2. Section 2 of Resolution 1074 is cancelled.
3. Section 5 of Resolution 1074 is amended to add the following: The District will continue to follow the orders of Federal, State and/or County public health agencies applicable to the District. The District may require a negative COVID-19 test as a condition of an employee returning to work in compliance with relevant health agency recommendations.

EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY, AND REPEALER


- a. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of Commissioners.
