### **RESOLUTION NO. 1121**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, authorizing District staff to acquire materials for public works projects.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 90 ("District") is a water special purpose district existing pursuant to Title 57 Revised Code of Washington ("RCW") owning and operating water systems within its corporate and service area boundaries in King County, Washington for the benefit of its customers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 57.08.050, the District is authorized to purchase equipment, supplies and materials in accordance with the procedures set forth therein;

WHEREAS, the District is engaged in the design of substantial public work projects, including the replacement of water mains and appurtenances, for the benefit of the District's water system and service to District customers;

WHEREAS, due to supply chain issues following the COVID pandemic, obtaining materials is often requiring significant lead time, and costs are in flux due to inflation and other economic impacts;

WHEREAS, material delays and cost increases could adversely impact the project schedules and budget for the public work projects;

WHEREAS, the District has determined that pre-purchasing materials will reduce the risk of project delays and cost uncertainties;

WHEREAS, the District complied with RCW 57.08.050 in providing notice and obtaining competitive bids for the purchase of materials. The District received two bids for the purchase of various materials were are set forth in the Bid Tabulation attached as **Exhibit 1**.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, as follows:

- 1. District staff are authorized to acquire materials in the quantities and amounts set forth in **Exhibit 1**, plus applicable tax, from Core & Main LP and/or H.D. Fowler, taking into consideration price and delivery schedule, but not to exceed \$754,236.25.
- 2. Darcey Peterson, as District Manager, or an employee acting at her direction, is authorized to sign such purchaser orders or other documents as may be appropriate for the procurement of the materials.

ADOPTED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, at a regular open public meeting thereof on the 6th day of September, 2022.
