

KCWD90 — UPGRADE PUMP STATIONS 7 & 8

WHAT?

- ♦ Upgrade Pump Stations 7 & 8
- Licorice Ferns Stations built in 1990's
- Pumps, Power Panels and Telemetry are obsolete.
- Pump and Communication failure at PS #7 forced the upgrade of the Pump Stations.



KCWD90 — UPGRADE PUMP STATIONS 7 & 8

Who?

Pump Stations 7 & 8 work together to serve 120 homes in the Licorice Ferns Neighborhood and surrounding areas.

> The District contracted with Award Construction on February 4, 2025.



KCWD90 — UPGRADE PUMP STATIONS 7 & 8

When?

- ♦ Construction has been delayed due to supply chain delays for new power panels (12 week delay).
- Construction expected to being in April of May of 2025.
 - ♦ Construction is 120 working days.
 - Expect completion by Oct or Nov 2025.



KCWD90 — UPGRADE PUMP STATIONS 7 & 8

Why?

- ♦ In March 2024, the District experienced theft of our Lumen Copper phone lines that allowed direct communications between our Office and our Pump Stations and Reservoirs via Telemetry.
 - ♦ Lumen is unable to repair or replace the phone lines.
 - ♦ The "fix" included adding Cellular Communications which required an upgrade of the Telemetry panels.
- ♦ A Pump Failure in Pump Station #7 in March 2024, required an upgrade of the Power Panels in Pump Station #7.
 - ♦ Pump Station #7 & #8 were built at the same time and work in tandem, requiring the upgrade of Pump Station #8 at the same time.



KCWD90 — UPGRADE PUMP STATIONS 7 & 8

What's Included?

- New Electrical Systems
- ♦ Pump and Motor Replacements— Pump Skids were purchased in advance by the District, to avoid any delays.
- ♦ New Telemetry Hardware and Software— Telemetry (aka SCADA) allows for remote viewing and control of all of our pumps and reservoirs so that they can be monitored and adjusted 24/7.

How Much?

- \Diamond PS #7 = \$631,0000
- ♦PS #8 = \$613,000
- ♦ Total project = \$1,244,000
